May Rains Increase Lake Erie Water Levels

Several days of thunderstorms and wet May overall are helping raise water levels on the Great Lakes. The Army Corps of Engineers says Lake Erie is five inches higher than it was last year. The other four Great Lakes are two to nine inches higher. But the Corps and the Great Lakes Commission says it would take many more downpours to bring the lakes back to normal. Lake Erie ran about six inches below its long-term average last year. Hydrologists had expected it to remain steady this year. Higher water levels usually mean fewer boats run aground.
